

Recruiting Process Timeline

Freshman Year:

- August
 - Start observing college soccer games during the season
 - Make sure to enroll in core courses
- December
 - Download a copy of NCAA guide for the College-Bound SA
 - Create a Priority List
- February
 - Create an Athletic and Academic Portfolio/Filing System
 - Create a Resume including Academics and Athletic Achievements
- May
 - Send Summer/Fall Schedule to Coaches
 - Mail out 1st contact letters to schools
 - Create a filing system – School information/Coaches Responses

Sophomore Year:

- August
 - Set Goals
 - Create a Priority List
 - Create a List of Potential Schools
- September
 - Email Coaches Fall Schedule / Events – *resend schedule changes as the arise*
 - Organize UNOFFICIAL Visits
- January/February
 - Set Goals
 - Attend ID Camps
 - Prepared a List of Questions for Coaches
 - List Possible areas of Study and the University which excel in the field of study
- March
 - Evaluate Grades and Studies with Guidance Counselor
 - Update your Resume including Academics and Athletic achievements
- May
 - Evaluate Grades and Studies with Guidance Counselor
 - Email Coaches Summer Schedule / Events

Junior Year:

- August
 - Update your Athletic and Academic Portfolio / Filing System
 - SAT and ACT Testing
 - Talk to Colligate Athletes - Experiences
- September
 - Email Coaches Fall Schedule / Events – resend schedule changes as the arise
 - Organize UNOFFICIAL Visits
- October
 - Enter the NCAA Clearinghouse – www.ncaaeligibilitycenter.org
- November
 - SAT and ACT Testing
- December
 - Update your Athletic and Academic Portfolio / Filing System
 - Talk to Colligate Athletes - Experiences
- January
 - Attend ID Camps
 - Prepared a List of Questions for Coaches
- February
 - SAT and ACT Testing
 - Email Coaches upcoming Schedules / Events
- May
 - Email Coaches Summer Schedule / Events
 - July 1st – Coaches can contact players entering Senior Yr.

Senior Year:

- August
 - 1st DAY of CLASS - OFFICIAL VISITS (schools typically organize in the Fall Season)
 - *Retake SAT and ACT Testing if necessary*
 - End of Junior Year / Sixth Semester - Forward your transcripts to the NCAA Eligibility Center
- September
 - Email Coaches Fall Schedule / Events – resend schedule changes as the arise
 - Schedule & Prepare for Official Visits
 - Attend ID Camps
- January
 - Financial Needs (Complete FAFSA as soon as possible after Jan 1)
- February
 - Signing National Letter of Intent
 - Enroll in the college of your choice
